1. About Gingerbread

2. Invitation to Tender

We are seeking to appoint a supplier to provide a **staff compliance e-learning platform** for up to **16 staff**. The solution should ensure all employees are able to complete mandatory compliance training in an accessible, user-friendly, and trackable way.

We welcome proposals from providers experienced in delivering e-learning platforms to the charity or public sector, especially those with an understanding of equity, safeguarding, and accessibility best practice.

3. Requirements

The platform must:

- Provide high-quality, up-to-date **compliance training** in:
 - Safeguarding (Adults and Children)
 - GDPR and Data Protection
 - o Equality, Diversity & Inclusion
 - Health & Safety
 - Cyber Security
- Be accessible online, on desktop and mobile
- Allow users to complete modules flexibly and independently
- Enable admin staff to:
 - Assign and track course completion
 - o Access real-time reports
 - Set reminders or deadlines
- Meet WCAG 2.1 AA accessibility standards
- Be cost-effective for a small team (up to 16 users)

Desirable features include:

- Option for custom branding
- Ability to upload or create bespoke modules
- Integrated support or technical helpdesk
- Certification or CPD accreditation for users
- Ability to add/remove users as staffing changes



4. Contract Term

• **Initial term:** 12 months (with the option to renew)

• **Start date:** September/October 2025

Submissions will be evaluated on the following:

Cost and value for money	35%
Platform functionality and user experience	25%
Accessibility and inclusivity	20%
Track record and relevant experience	15%
Implementation and support	5%

Please provide a written proposal of no more than **6 pages**, covering:

- Overview of your platform and services
- How your solution meets our requirements
- Pricing model and total costs (inc. VAT if applicable)
- Case studies or testimonials from similar clients
- Support, onboarding and implementation offer
- Contact details and company information

You may also include a link to a demo or walkthrough video.
